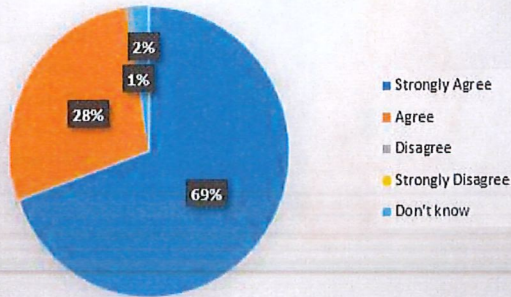
Once again, thank you to all those who completed the survey. We will continue to work hard, acting on your feedback and ensuring the school meets your expectations and provides the very best education our children deserve.

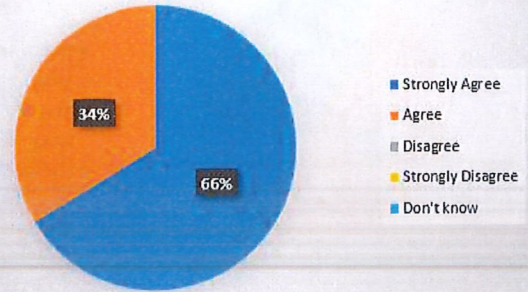

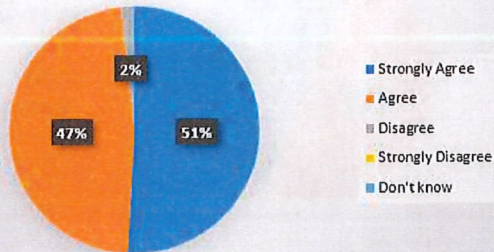

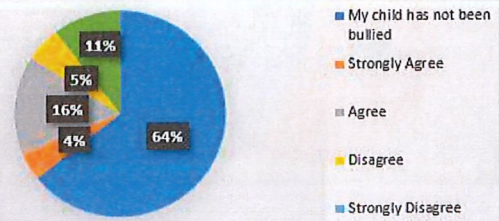
2. My child feels safe at this school



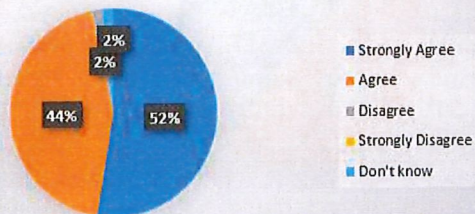
