In Maths, children will be beginning to focus on fractions and how to convert units of measurement.

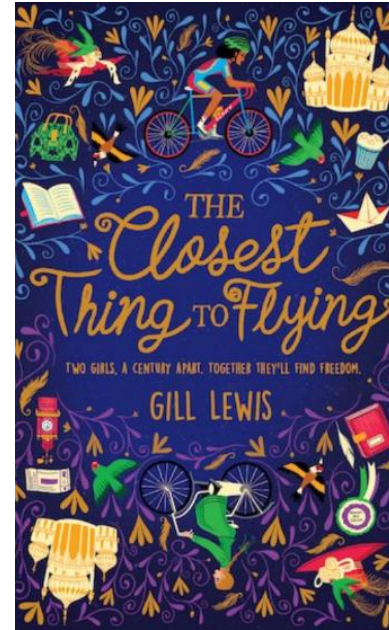

PE

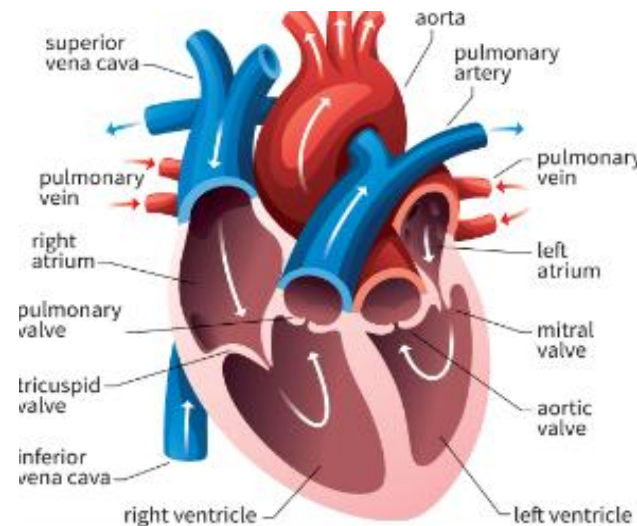
This term we will be doing circuits and our PE days are on Thursday and Friday.
